
## **How to Read Your Meter**

Drop the stationary 0 and the last black number to get your reading.

A spinning wheel indicates you have a leak

One full circle of the dial results in 10 gallons of water used.



## If you suspect you have a leak:

Turn off the shut off valve going into your house from the ground (if you have one). Look at your leak detector to see if spinning. If so, then leak is between your meter and shut off valve.

If that doesn't spin, make sure everything in house is turned off. Turn shut off valve back on and look at leak detector. If it is spinning, then leak is between the shut off valve and your house. (You might have to sit and wait for 10-15 min. for a toilet leak to show up.)

Another easy way to check toilet leaks is to put food coloring in the toilet tank. DO NOT FLUSH THE TOILET!! Let the dye sit in the tank for 10-20 minutes. If any color is in the toilet bowl, then the toilet is leaking.
